

RAI Privacy and Data Processing Statement

RAI Surveys

Through this statement RAI informs all those from whom it collects personal data about which kind of data RAI collects, how this happens, where these data are kept, what RAI does with these data, who has access to these data, to whom these data is distributed, what our legal basis is to keep these data, for how long we keep them, how it is protected and how people of whom RAI collects data can execute their rights regarding this data.

Which personal data do we collect?

If you fill out a RAI Survey, we ask you to leave us your name, your employer and your email address. We also ask other data from you, but those can not be considered personal data.

Where are the data kept?

The data will be managed by survey tools, such as Google Forms and by processing tools, such as Google Spreadsheets.

What do we do with these data?

We use these data to get back in touch with you in case we have extra questions or to ask you to participate also in future surveys. We don't use this data for anything else. When we process the non-personal data that come out of the survey, we make sure that none of the answers is traceable to you, unless you give us your explicit, separate, active written agreement.

Who has access to these data?

To whom are these data distributed?

We will never intentionally communicate this data to any other party for their use, if this use doesn't coincide strictly and only with ours.

What is our legal basis to process these data?

Our legal basis to process these data can be defined as explicit consent. By filling out a RAI Survey and approving the Privacy and Data Processing Statement mentioned or linked to in there, you actively agree that your data is used as described in this RAI Privacy and Data Processing Statement.

For how long do we keep these data? What happens to the data after use?

We keep this data until you ask us to remove it.

How is this data protected?

The data is protected via the security and privacy measures of the tool with which it is managed. For Google Forms and Google Spreadsheets these measures are set in the terms of use of the tool. They include a password protection.

How can I view, alter or delete this data, object to its preservation, apply my right to be forgotten? How can I withdraw my permissions, execute my transferability rights, refuse to profiling or limit the processing of my data?
